TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE EUROPEAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS

Dear Mr. President,

Let me please, herewith protest against the decision of the European Court of Human Rights dated from 20.05.2008 and ask for a retrial at the Great Chamber of the Court. I want to present the grounds for this.

During the years 1998 and 1999, my rights were violated many times. In the Republic of Germany, for example, in 1999 the German police had forced me to sign a document. This was a clear breach of my human rights.

Afterwards since 2000, I have 16 different cases which were to my mind absolutely contrary to the law. The courts made me through such decisions. These law violations I have 16 different cases.

In 2004, I applied to the European Court of Human Rights in Berlin. Case Nr. 746 and all other cases. I applied to the German Bundestag in 2004, but they did not deal with my case (Article 34 of the Convention on Human Rights). I applied to the German Constitutional Court at first dealt at the German

Constitutional Court at first dealt at the German Constitutional Court. I applied to the highest instance courts of Germany also at the same time: OLG, Kammergericht, Kammergericht. These courts did not solve my problems either (respectively, the decision of the Bundesverwaltungsgericht from 03.07.2007, case Nr. 1 ER 126.07, and the decision of the Bundesverfassungsgericht from Dezember 2007, case Nr. 1 BvR 2918 / 07). Please take into consideration, that on the one hand I have no legal education, on the other I am very ill both mental and physical. In spite of these I tried always to use all local remedies in
