TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE EUROPEAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS

Dear Mr. President,

I have asked you at 21.01.2009 for help, because the Berlin justice, officials and the police exercise an inhuman pressure and psychological terror which, the whole of that makes me do a suicide. They have written at 23.01.2009 that stands in the law of human rights that you have legally no influence to prevent the internal psychological terror, and those policemen who are trying to come into my flat, the whole of that makes me do a suicide.

But in my opinion stands in the law of human rights that you must take care of this case, to bring me in another European democratic land , for example Switzerland , and to prevent my suicide. Still it is not too late for help me and to take care of my case. The reason for my suicide is that I want that the court of human rights take care to my thing acts. What I require, is, actually, no big request, it should be natural, actually, because I am even a person who has a right on a normal life. I do not have to become a victim of this situation, so that the truth comes to light.

For many years I answered all questions of the German courts. If I had a crisis, I always lost. No matter whether I answer or do not answer, the opinions of me are always the same. I am the person who gets no answer of his questions. Who is responsible for my 16 heavy illnesses? Even if I came ill to Germany, why I was treated during 9 years by the justice inhumanly? Or have I got by this inhuman treatment these illnesses? Was I then a healthy person to whom you have been off sick? Or was I an ill person whom you have sentenced to death?

In the UN-session on February 2, 2009 was proved that the German state prevents the consideration of the criminal court cases related to the immigrants by the negative migration politics and public support. This fact can be seen in the following internet site:


